

2016-17 Lumberton Township School District Goals

Goal #1- The district will implement the IQWST science curriculum in grades 6-8

- The district will complete purchase of materials
- The district will update curriculum to reflect alignment to Next Generation Science Standards
- The district will train staff on the program
 - We will continue work with Rider University SELECT (if chosen)
 - We will continue with Science Leadership Team work
 - We will utilize expertise of IQWST and provide workshops through them
- Students will have access to the online software that compliments the program
- The Board Education Committee or full board will have a demonstration of the program after implementation has commenced

Goal #2- The district will continue to implement the 2016-19 Strategic Plan

- Each Implementation Team will hold a minimum of three meetings during the year
- The superintendent will attend a meeting for each Implementation Team and assist in the development action plans using the district template
- Action plans will appear on board agendas a minimum of two times next year
- The Board will receive updates from the liaison (superintendent) or chairs at either the whole board level or committee level (as appropriate)
- The district will develop and distribute community communication on the attainment of our Strategic Plan

Goal #3- The District will continue to integrate technology towards 21st century learning

- 5th and 7th grades will implement a 1:1 Chromebook initiative (all 5th and 7th grade students and teachers will have a Chromebook as a learning/teaching tool)
 - The district will purchase sufficient devices to carry out the implementation
 - The district will hold professional development sessions to support teacher growth in the areas of:
 - 1:1 implementation
 - Google Classroom
 - The district will examine possible visits to other districts
- The district will improve Internet connectivity to support the 1:1 initiative
 - Broadband will be increased in BRS and LMS to support the initiative
 - Additional access points will be installed in LMS to support the initiative
- The technology/curriculum implementation team will assist in the implementation
- The budget will reflect the addition of a shared technology teacher between Walther and Ashbrook Schools
 - The Ashbrook and Walther principals will develop a schedule in collaboration
 - The teacher will design lessons aligned to NJ curriculum standards for technology in kindergarten and first grade
