

Board Goals 2017-2018

Goal #1 - The Board seeks to develop a community-wide vision for our district through the Strategic Planning process.

- The Board will support the Strategic Plan Implementation by having one representative participate on each of the Implementation Teams.

Goal #2 - The Board seeks to continue efforts around community engagement in the 2017-18 school year.

- The Board will hold a minimum of four student recognitions at the beginning of their public meetings in the 2017-18 school year.
- The Governance Committee will meet with the LTEA to exchange feedback on the 2017-18 program and agree on potential modifications for next year.
- The Board will continue to have one representative present at each PTA meeting during the 2017-18 school year.

Goal #3 - The Board seeks opportunities for it to become better educated about current educational issues as well as learning which could improve board effectiveness.

- A board representative will attend each NJSBA Delegate Assembly. The Board will prepare for the Delegate Assembly by discussing the issues and agenda in advance and agreeing upon our votes.
- The Board will work to improve the New Board Member experience by updating the New Board Member Manual.
- A minimum of two (2) current topics relevant to the field of education will be presented to the entire Board by sitting Board members.

Goal #4 - The Board will continue the Proactive Policy review started in 2015-16 by completing a proactive review of two (2) policies in 2017-18, selected through a collaborative process with our Superintendent and B.A.

Goal #5 – The Board will seek to strengthen interpersonal relationships amongst members.

- A minimum of seven members will have a personal interaction with two other board members during the year (i.e., coffee or lunch meetings)
- Each Board member will share a lunch or breakfast meal with the Superintendent during the school year.
