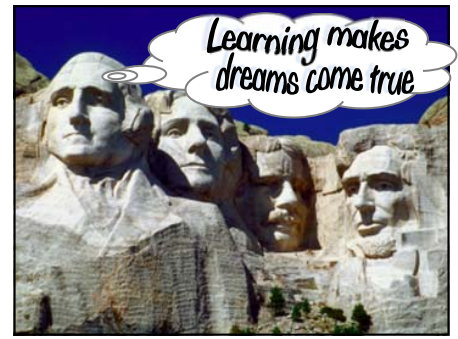

NURSE NOTES

- ✦ During the winter months, the atmosphere is robbed of humidity and we experience dry, cracked skin. The health office sees a multitude of students complaining of chapped lips and the immediate solution is to apply Vaseline. Your child is permitted to carry lip balm with them during school hours and thereby avoid missing valuable class time for this simple remedy.
- ✦ Just as students should be prepared for class with their books, pencils, etc. they should also be prepared for their Physical Education class by wearing sneakers on that particular cycle day in their schedule. Sneakers provide the proper support to absorb impact and appropriate tread for engaging in many activities. Additionally, students should be prepared for the weather. The students go out for recess unless the weather is too cold (below freezing and cloudy) or there is significant precipitation. Although we have been forced indoors recently for recess due to outside conditions, many students still walk to school and we are frequently encountering "wet sock syndrome." So please ensure your children are dressed appropriately before they walk out the door: boots, sneakers, extra pair of socks, hat, gloves, and a warm coat are necessities to keep your child safe, warm and dry during this winter season.
- ✦ Has there been any change in your child's medical history, such as starting, stopping, or changing medication? A new diagnosis? Immunizations or physical? If so, it is very important to let me know so your child's medical information is accurate and complete.
