Clinic times & General Info

Getting a flu shot is the best thing you can do to protect yourself and your loved ones from the flu this season. Clinics will be held on **Thursdays**.

Adult Clinics are for individuals 18 years of age and older. *No children will be vaccinated.*

Children's Clinics will be held on October 3, November 7, December 5, December 26, January 2, 2020, & January 9, 2020. **All children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.** (*Legal guardians please bring document showing proof of guardianship*).

There will be **one drive-thru clinic** on **Wednesday, October 23, 2019** and **two drive-thru clinics** on **Saturday, November 2, 2019**.

ALL drive-thru clinics are for individuals 18 years of age and older.

Pneumonia vaccines are no longer offered. Please contact your doctor to get a pneumonia vaccine.

Vaccinations are available free of charge to residents. Donations are appreciated at \$15 for the flu shot.
