- ◇ The current security system is analog, has poor video quality, and is not web accessible.
- ◇ LMS carpeting is 27 years old.
- ◇ BRS carpeting is 20 years old.
- ◇ BRS boiler is over 20 years old.
- ◇ Ashbrook carpeting is 15 years old.
- ◇ The roof at both the Walther and Lumberton Middle Schools are no longer under warranty.
