



BUS PROCEDURES AND PRACTICE

Bus safety is of the utmost importance. Providing a distraction-free, safe ride is the goal. Students should practice proper safety and respectful behavior at the bus stop and on the bus.

BUS EXPECTATIONS

- Use inside voices while on the bus;
- Always use kind and appropriate language;
- Keep your seatbelt on at all times, back to the seat, feet in front;
- Share your seat as necessary;
- Keep hands and feet to yourself;
- Keep the bus clean and the aisle clear;
- All body parts and student materials **MUST** remain inside the bus;
- Stay in sight of the bus driver while walking in front of the bus;
- Never touch the emergency exit door or windows, unless otherwise directed by the driver;
- Let the bus driver know if you are having a problem when the bus is **NOT** in motion.
- Report any concerns.

RECOGNITION

Students that maintain proper bus safety have the opportunity to earn a “caught being good on the bus” token and will be recognized for their great choices.
